Mr. Rooney stated that he contacted our Board attorney and the Spotswood Superintendent of Schools regarding the incident and noted that the correspondence is in the agenda for Board acceptance.

- 1. Mr. Rooney stated that he and Dr. Ledford and Mrs. Jordan met with the coordinator of the Carbone Clinic on December 18, 2014 and worked through prior concerns and issues. Mr. Rooney noted that two cohorts have been formed and a schedule of three visits a month have been established. Mr. Rooney stated that he believes the relationship between the Shore Center and the Carbone Clinic is moving in a positive direction.
- 2. Mr. Rooney discussed the budget noting the consideration of hiring a full time OT; however, the cost of health benefits would total an additional \$100,000.00 per year to the district.

Mr. Rooney asked for the Board's opinions as to the long term direction they would like to see for the program. Mr. Rooney discussed options of expanding the program to include maintaining the program as is for another year, progressing to a 21 and over program and starting a program in Ocean County. Discussion ensued regarding the options and it was the Board's opinion that progressing to a 21 and over program should be the priority and that would hopefully create expansion of the entire program.

Questions/discussion ensued regarding the maximum number of students. Mr. Rooney noted that the classrooms are close to capacity at every level.

Dear Mr. Rocco:

On Thursday December 18, 2014 at approximately 3:00 pm the Monmouth Ocean Educational Services Commission (MOESC) received written confirmation that the Spotswood School District would place a student at The Shore Center for Students with Autism. MOESC provides administrative services to The Shore Center for Students with Autism via a shared services agreement with the Bayshore Jointure Commission Board of Directors.

On Friday December 19, 2014, the Spotswood Director of Special Services, Mr. Daniel Silvia called the MOESC offices and stated that if a contract was not received by close of business that day Spotswood would place the student elsewhere. Additionally, the Director of Special Services for Spotswood wanted the student to begin on Monday, December 22, 2014, knowing that the school week consisted of one and half days due to the holiday break.

At MOESC and the Bayshore Jointure Commission, the Superintendent, the Business Administrator or both review all contracts. The Superintendent that day was at the Monmouth County Round Table while the Business Administrator was at the Ocean County Round Table. Both the Superintendent and Business Administrator were pulled out of their meetings to deal with this issue.

Upon receiving the information that if in fact MOESC did not act immediately, Spotswood would place the student elsewhere for their educational program. The Superintendent of MOESC asked the Assistant Superintendent of MOESC to call the Director of Special Services of Spotswood to clarify these remarks.

At that time, the Director of Special Services of Spotswood confirmed his earlier demands but added that if MOESC failed to act, he held positions of leadership at the county level for the Middlesex County Special Education and Guidance Directors and Middlesex Regional Educational Services Commission whereby he would besmirch the Shore Center for Students with Autism, MOESC and NJ Virtual School ®, a division of MOESC, as well as the MOESC Online Training In-Service Seminars (OTIS). The Spotswood Director further stated that he would be active in preventing students from Middlesex County not only from enrolling in The Shore Center but all of MOESC programming. After his conversation with the Assistant Superintendent of MOESC, he called the Principal of the Shore Center for Autism making insulting remarks and stated his further criticism and dissatisfaction for MOESC and the Bayshore Jointure Commission and made further demands for the student to start on Monday, December 22, 2014.

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Though a contract was issued in less than twenty-four hours for the student to begin on January 5, 2015, on behalf of the Bayshore Jointure Commission Board of Directors, MOESC rescinds the contract and therefore will not be accepting the student from Spotswood at this time.

We sincerely regret this decision, however, we are unable to enter into a business agreement to provide services under these circumstances.

Upon consultation with the Board Attorney for Monmouth Ocean Educational Services Commission and the Bayshore Jointure Commission, should any employee of Spotswood seek to defame, liable or slander any programs operated by MOESC, the Shore Center for Students with Autism or Bayshore Jointure Commission legal action would be forthcoming upon that individual and their employer.

While MOESC regrets the position it has been placed in on behalf of the student and the family, there was no viable option other than this course of action.

After speaking with you and Dr. Silvia, I am satisfied that although he made statements that he should not have made, he was motivated only by his desire to see that a deserving special education student receive much-needed services. In the heat of the moment and completely out of character based on his interactions with educators from our county and state, he let his passion get the better of him, and he deeply regrets his actions. On behalf of the Spotswood School District, I extend my sincere apologies for what has occurred.

Dr. Silvia is a highly experienced professional with over a decade's worth of exemplary service to public education, and I can assure you that neither Dr. Silvia nor anyone else on behalf of our District has any intention of maligning your organization, and trust that we can move forward from here in a spirit of mutual goodwill. It is my hope that in the future you will consider making available your school district's services to any needy students in the Spotswood School District.
