The Autism Services Network (ASN) is an extension of GSAPP's Psychological Services Network that offers free phone and video conferencing support and resources for individuals and families affected by Autism Spectrum Disorder. This cost-free support will be provided by Rutgers-affiliated Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBAs), Clinical Psychologists, or advanced, supervised trainees with experience in ASD.

Contact the Autism Services Network for access to free individualized resources, supportive short-term coaching and guidance, and possible referrals for more intensive and long-term service arrangements. Some examples of how the GSAPP-ASN can help are by:

- Fostering independent activities and routines in the home
- Suggesting strategies to promote social engagement within functional activities and play
- Providing ideas to manage changes in routine and developing new functional routines in daily life
- Offering support to foster leisure and vocational skills and interests
- Serving as a resource for developing skills like toilet training
- Coping Strategies and mental health support for parents and siblings
